

LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LMS) END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA)

EFFECTIVE DATE: January 2, 2024

This agreement governs all access to the USJ Learning Management System. By logging into the platform, users acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by these institutional terms.

1. Grant of License

Subject to the terms of this Agreement, USJ grants the User a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, and revocable license to access and use the USJ Learning Management System (LMS) solely for official educational purposes, including course attendance, assessment submission, and virtual classroom participation.

2. Authorized Access and Authentication

Users must authenticate via USJ-approved credentials. Sharing of login credentials is strictly prohibited. The User is responsible for all activity occurring under their account and must immediately notify the USJ IT Department of any unauthorized access.

3. Intellectual Property Rights

All course materials, lectures, digital textbooks, and the LMS software architecture are the exclusive property of the University of Justice or its licensors. Users may not record, download (unless permitted), reproduce, or redistribute any content without express written consent from the Office of the Provost.

4. Data Privacy and GDPR Compliance

USJ is committed to protecting user data. By using the LMS, the User consents to the collection of academic performance data, engagement metrics, and login logs. All data processing is governed by the USJ Data Privacy Policy and complies with international standards, including GDPR for global students.

5. Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

Users agree not to: (a) Attempt to circumvent system security or encryption; (b) Upload malicious code or viruses; (c) Engage in academic dishonesty via the platform; or (d) Use the virtual classroom environment for harassment or non-academic solicitations.

6. Virtual Classroom Conduct

Virtual classrooms are professional environments. USJ reserves the right to record sessions for quality assurance and academic review. Users are expected to maintain professional etiquette and adhere to the Institutional Code of Conduct during live sessions.

7. System Maintenance and Availability

USJ strives for 99.9% uptime but does not guarantee uninterrupted service. Scheduled maintenance will be communicated 24 hours in advance via the LMS dashboard. USJ is not liable for data loss occurring due to user-side internet connectivity issues.

8. Termination of Access

USJ reserves the right to suspend or terminate LMS access immediately for: (a) Non-payment of tuition; (b) Violation of this License Agreement; or (c) Withdrawal from the University. Upon termination, the license to use the materials is revoked.
